<u>Theme:</u> Panel on France as a "Start-up Nation in Europe", on French tech initiatives and on cooperation between French entrepreneurs and French Startups and Hong Kong and Shenzhen ecosystems

## Speakers:



- Professor Alistair Cole, Professor of Political Science at the University of Cardiff and Sciences Po Lyon (he was the Vincent Wright Chair Professor in 2007 in Sciences Po Paris). He will publish a book on Emmanuel Macron leadership style in March 2019. Professor Cole is a graduate of LSE and Oxford University. He will talk about President Macron political leadership in a shorter version of the address he will make at the Hong Kong Foreign Correspondents Club on November 30<sup>th</sup>.



- Mrs. Alicia Garcia-Herrero, Chief Economist Asia for Natixis, Senior Research Fellow at BRUEGEL, Senior Research Fellow at El Cano Royal Institute for International Relations, adjunct professor at University of Science and Technology (HKUST) as well as HKUST Business School, Member of the Board of the Hong Kong Forum, member of the Council of Advisors of the Hong Kong Monetary Authority Institute for Monetary Research (HKMA). Alicia will talk about reforms in France and in the European Union.



- Mr Romain Aubert, representative of La French Tech (Shenzhen) will explain the latest French Tech policy measures announced in October 2018 (notably the policy linked to French Tech visas, the launch of French Tech communities and French Tech Capitals).



- Mr Hugo Garcia-Cotte, the French senior Manager of Cypheme (Cypheme is a Shenzhen based company which created an artificial intelligence capable of detecting counterfeit products by analyzing the product's packaging with a neural network, using only a cellphone camera). He will talk about his own journey as a French entrepreneur with a Shenzhen-based business. He went through "500 Startups" in the Silicon Valley, Microsoft Accelerator Paris, Lafayette Plug and Play and Station F in France.
